#### **GENERAL REGULATION**

---

##### **1: RULES DEFINITION AND OBSERVATION**

The Granfondo Luberon Mormoiron Top Vélo – Tribute to Fausto Coppi is a Cyclo sport event.

It will take place in Mormoiron (84), on the Saturday 25th of May 2019.

It appears on the national calendar of the French Federation of Cyclism (F.F.C) and is open to everyone – licensees or not.

The event is organized by Vélo Concept and with the help of the OCP Club from the F.F.C South Region committee, the city of Mormoiron and Top Vélo magazine on both the 85 and the 125 km distances.

The event is compliant with :

- The 18th of October 1955, 55 – 1366 decree called « Cyclism events regulation on public roads » and the NOR INT/D/04/00063C circular issued on the 25th of May 2004, which, according to the 55 decree, stipulates the official recognition of the cyclo sporting event.
- The technical regulation for the organization of a Cyclo sport event, a text which was validated by the presidents of the concerned federations on the 8th of December 2006 at the French Olympic and Sporting Committee.

The participants of the Granfondo Luberon Mormoiron Top Velo event are obliged to be aware of the general regulations of the event under any circumstances.

In case of dispute on the application form, the unawareness of the rules will not be in any case a valid excuse.

##### **2 : CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION**

The event is opened to any cyclist of any nationality over 18 (born before the 1st of January 2001), licensee or not.

In accordance with the 5th of April 2006 L.231-3 article of the Sport's Code, on the law related to the protection of the sportive's health and the anti-doping campaign, the participation of sportive competitions organized or authorized by Cyclism federations is subordinate to the presentation of a sporting licence (F.F.C, F.F, Tri, F.S.G.T, U.F.O.L.E.P) certifying the issue of a medical certificate mentioning the absence of contraindication for competitive cyclism, or for non-licensee to whom the race is opened, the presentation of only this certificate or its copy, which must be less than one year old, to the 17th of March 2019.

Participants who are F.F.C licensees must join to their registration the photocopy of their licence (2018-2019), and commit to presenting it during the handing over of the bibs. Other competitors (non-licensees and licensees of another Federation) will have to present the original or the photocopy of a medical certificate including the « Do not show any contraindication for the practice of sports in competition » mention, that must be less than a year old on the 17th of March 2019. This medical certificate will be provided after the registration and/or presented during the handing over of the bibs. Under-aged competitors (junior category) can participate to the race upon presentation of a parental consent. The organizer will not be held responsible in any case of health incident that might occur to any participant, before, during, and after the event.

### **3 : REGISTRATION**

This registration can also be done by sending a regular mail after the request and sending of the registration form or by downloading the form directly on the websites.

In order to be validated, the registration form must be attached to the requested papers and the regulation that matches the stated modalities.

Any incomplete registration file will be put on hold before the receiving of the missing attachments and will be taken care of at the « Incomplete files » desk before the race.

Registration will be closed on the 22nd of May at midnight, registration on-site at a premium rate will be possible on Friday the 24th of May and on Saturday the 25th of May morning (before 8h30) 2019.

The registration is final and no refund will be granted.

The registration fees for every competitor are :

**4 : LIABILITY INSURANCE**

Every competitor will have to have a personal accident insurance or a liability insurance, either by being a licensee in a sports federation, or by having a personal one. Every competitor is committed to this rule by signing the registration form and admits having acknowledged the offer proposed by the organizer in the registration form. The organizer will therefore not be held responsible in any case of incidents that may occur before, during, or after the event.

Within the same framework, the liability insurance of every contributor, assistants and staff members will not be engaged before, during, or after the event.

**5. SPORTIVE RULES**

The Granfondo Luberon Mormoiron Top Vélo – Souvenir Fausto Coppi, will take place under the auspices of the French Federation of Cyclism (F.F.C), the sporting regulations come from the technical rules for the organization of a cyclo sporting event.

Men and Women categories are the following :

**Cat M1/F1 : 18/34 years old**

**Cat M2/F2 : 35/39 years old**

**Cat M3/F3 : 40/44 years old**

**Cat M4/F4 : 45/49 years old**

**Cat M5/F5 : 50/54 years old**

**Cat M6/F6 : 55/59 years old**

**Cat M7/F7 : 60/64 years old**

**Cat M8/F8 : 65/69 years old**

**Cat M9/F9 : + 70 years old**

**Cat H : Disabled Sports**

Categories will be identified by the gigs' different colors, using the international standards of color coding (UCI)

Active professionals are admitted on invitation.

A categorization will be done as well as an overall ranking.

## **6 : RACE DESCRIPTIVE**

The race will be coordinated by a race supervisor who will be assisted by several certified commissioners, who will permanently be on the race, from the very start to the finish of the last competitor.

The F.F.C will delegate a few representatives whom function will be determined in coordination with the sportive direction of the event.

## **7 : SECURITY AND PROTECTION OF THE COMPETITORS**

The race will benefit from a security system applied by bikers and protection on non-priority crossroads.

According to the decree and after the final recognition of the trails, a privatisation of the roads will be requested for the first hour of the race. Generally speaking, it is requested that the traffic regulations are fully respected.

A sweep vehicle will close the race after the cyclists.

A request of convention will be addressed to the National Gendarmerie in order to reinforce the mobility of the race which will be supervised by a group of bikers specialized in sportive events security on public roads, official signalers will be placed at every non-priority crossroads and in every area that is judged delicate for the security of the competitors (villages crossing).

## **8 : MODALITIES FOR DEPARTURE AND DELAYS**

The start for both trails will be given at 9.30am for every man from the 60+ categories (M7/M8/M9), every woman from all categories (F1 to F9) and H category. 9.40am for every other Man category.

The exact starting and finishing place in Mormoiron (84) will be decided later on. The schedule can be re-evaluated depending on the circumstances and conditions, every competitor will be informed beforehand during the withdrawal of the gigs.

Delays will be established in order to achieve the races, the closure of the finish controls will be based on the progress of the closing vehicle which will be calculated at the average of 22 km/h.

Every competitor who shall be overtaken by the closing vehicle will be considered outside of the race framework and will then have to continue the race under his entire responsibility.

## **9 : THE PERMANENT SERVICE OF RECEPTION OF THE RACE**

The permanent service of reception will be open the day before the race, on Friday, 24th of May (exact place decided later on), from 10am and will stay open until the end of the official protocol of the awards ceremony, on Saturday, 25th of May.

## **10 : EMERGENCY PHONE NUMBER**

An emergency phone number will be given to every competitor, it may only be used in case of an accident or when a competitor should require medical assistance.

## **11 : ASSOCIATED ENTERTAINMENTS AND SERVICES**

Every competitor of the GFLM Top Vélo – Tribute to Fausto Coppi will have access to the following services :

- A participation file and the sportive services associated to it
- Goodies from the organization and its partners
- A closure meal and award ceremony protocol on Saturday, 25th of May at 2.30pm

The participation to the closure meal may be granted to accompanying persons after the purchase of a ticket at the concerned desk, which will be opened during the permanent service of reception the day before and the morning before the race, no ticket will be delivered after the race.

## **12 : DURING THE RACE BEHAVIOR**

Every competitor must have a fairplay and responsible behavior during the race towards other competitors and concerning personal waste. A special system will be implemented in order to ensure the global control of the waste and the protection of the sites, the Green Cycling Eco Cyclo patrol will be especially attentive to the behaviour of the competitors during the race, in any case of polluting behaviour, the competitor may be first warned, then disqualified according to the measures taken by the commissioners.

## **13 : MEDICAL CONTROL**

According to the international and national sporting regulation, competitors may be subject to medical checks at the end of the race, any violation of these checks or refusal to comply with them will lead to the instant disqualification of the concerned competitor and legal consequences that may follow.

## **14 : MATERIAL AND EQUIPMENT**

The material used by the competitors must comply with the general regulations that regulate cycle road races. Triathlon-like handlebars extensions are forbidden. Rigid helmets are mandatory for every competitor during the race.

## **15 : ASSISTANCE VEHICLES**

Certified assistance vehicles will be essentially affected to the security, medical services and sportive direction of the race, any other personal and non-accredited vehicle is forbidden inside the race.

The presence of any personal vehicles may lead to the disqualification of the concerned competitors.

## **16 : MEDIAS AND IMAGE RIGHTS**

The organizer reserves an exclusive image right for every competitor during the entire race.

Specific contracts can be concluded with the competitors willing to ensure themselves personal media services.

**These contracts will be private and will only concern competitors who have requested them beforehand.**

### **17 : CONCLUSIONS**

**These general rules can evolve, the organizer reserves the right to change them according to the circumstances.**

**This regulation can be consulted and downloaded in PDF format on the websites that will carry out the online registration service.**

**Every registered competitor agrees to have read it.**

**For their interpretation and observation, the french law and traffic regulations are the legal and official foundations.**
